

# Measurements guide

## HOW TO MEASURE

The first step to start your installation project, even before purchase, is to take measurements of the surfaces to be covered. There are a multitude of shapes and sizes of walls, which is what makes them their charm. This reality can complicate the taking of measurements, which is why we have prepared a guide to help you.


## DIFFERENT WALL CONFIGURATIONS

### Standard wall

You have a wall to cover?

Measure the height and width of the wall. Be careful, we recommend that you measure in more than one place and always select the longest measurement. You must add 1 inch in height and 1 inch in width in order to anticipate any losses related to the imperfections of the wall.

Do not take into account baseboards or mouldings.




### Several continuous walls

You have several walls to cover with the same wallpaper?

Measure the height and add up all the widths of your walls, to create a single large image. You do not need to order two separate wallpapers.

Be careful, we recommend that you measure in more than one place and always select the longest measurement. You must add 1 inch in height and 1 inch in width in order to anticipate any losses related to the imperfections of the wall. Do not take into account baseboards or mouldings.




## Wall with one or more slopes

Is your wall sloped?

Take your measurements, as if it were a rectangle or a square, without taking into account the slopes. Be careful, we recommend that you measure in more than one place and always select the longest measurement. You must add 1 inch in height and 1 inch in width in order to anticipate any losses related to the imperfections of the wall.

We will send you the wallpaper in the form of a rectangle or a whole square. You will then be able to cut the excess during the installation.

Do not take into account baseboards or mouldings.



## Wall with obstacles

Does your wall contain a window or a door?

Take your measurements, as if it were a rectangle or a square, without taking into account the obstacles. Be careful, we recommend that you measure in more than one place and always select the longest measurement. You must add 1 inch in height and 1 inch in width in order to anticipate any losses related to the imperfections of the wall.

We will send you the wallpaper in the form of a rectangle or a whole square.

You will then be able to cut the excess during the installation.

Do not take into account baseboards or mouldings.

It is important to anticipate that an image may contain important parts that could be removed during installation. We will be happy to help you make an informed choice so that the position of the obstacle does not interfere with the final effect. We will provide you with a preview of the visual on your wall before confirming the order.
